If there is an occasion when you are unable to access Google Classroom, please follow the plan below. **This learning route should only be used if you cannot access the resources your teacher has provided.**

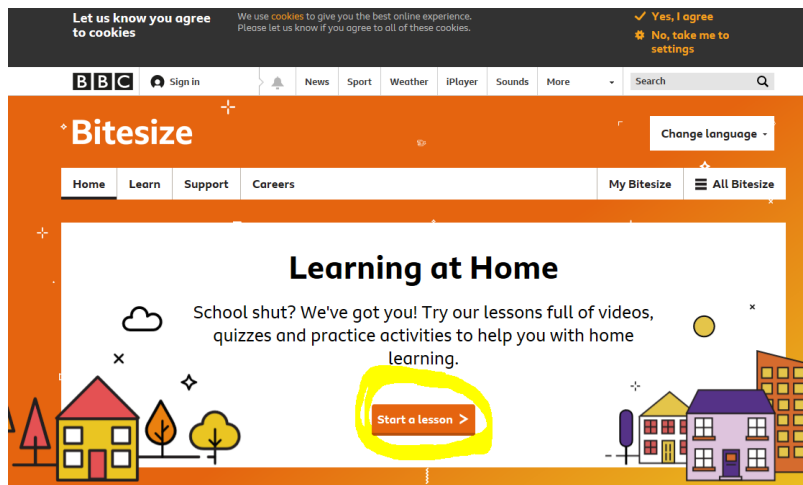
Please follow the guidance with links to learning activities which will allow you to follow the usual timetable.
